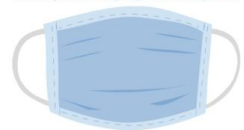

They use it when referring to the newly named Community Paramedic, Greg Tussing. The Community Assistance Referrals and Education Services began in December 2018. Greg, a firefighter-paramedic, was assigned to serve as the Community Paramedic.

What can the Community Paramedic do for you? Through their collaboration with many community resources, they can help connect you with a variety of services. A few of

the most common services they can help with are: basic medical evaluations and collaboration with your physician, fall prevention, nutrition services and cleaning and home repair. Referrals to CARES come from a variety of places: recently released from hospital or a rehab facility or even a friend or neighbor concerned about an individual. Come and hear more. It's a fabulous program!
