The Grove City Police Department has added a new position that can be a very important resource for the city’s older citizens – Elder Services Coordinator. And Teri Ruslander was hired for the job! Ms. Ruslander worked for the Grove City Division of Police for 33 years; 24 of those years were spent as a detective. She has worked violent crimes like homicides, rapes, and robberies. However, she said it was the exploitation cases targeting the elderly that were some of her most difficult cases to work. She retired from the police department in 2019. Now she will serve in this civilian role on a part-time basis. She will help senior citizens and their families connect to resources they may not know are available to them. She will work to educate seniors and those working on behalf of seniors, including clergy and assisted living employees.
