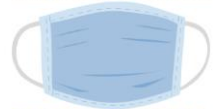
READER SIGN-UP SHEETS for October, November, and December are posted in the North Entrance. Please volunteer to read the scriptures at a worship service this Fall.

THE OWLS (Older, Wiser, Lutheran Seniors) will meet on October 16 at 1pm in the FLC. The Grove City Police Department has added a new position that can be a very important resource for the city’s older citizens – Elder Services Coordinator. And Teri Ruslander was hired for the job! Ms. Ruslander worked for the Grove City Division of Police for 33 years; 24 of those years were spent as a detective. She has worked violent crimes like homicides, rapes, and robberies. However, she said it was the exploitation cases targeting the elderly that were some of her most difficult cases to work. She retired from the police department in 2019. Now she will serve in this civilian role on a part-time basis. She will help senior citizens and their families connect to resources they may not know are available to them. She will work to educate seniors and those working on behalf of seniors, including clergy and assisted living employees.

How to give to St. John's:

1. During worship services or drive-thru communion.
2. Mail your offering to the church – 3220 Columbus St., Grove City, Ohio 43123
3. Through your financial institution – they will send a check directly to the church on your behalf.
4. St. John's website – www.stjohnsgc.org – online giving is available through Vanco Services, and we have partnered with them for more than 20 years. It is secure and safe.
5. Through the **GivePlus** app available from Apple or Google – again a partnership between the church and Vanco Services. Set up a profile one time, and set up a recurring gift, or give when you want to. Once your profile is set up, giving is a one-touch process.
