<u>CHURCH UPDATING/REMODELING PROJECTS</u>: With the buildings closed to outside use, it has been the perfect time to do a number of projects in the Education Building like new flooring, painting, and bathroom remodels and updating.

Next on the list of projects: new replacement ceiling light fixtures for the second floor of the Education Building have been ordered. The new ceiling lights are all LED, which means no burnt out bulbs or burnt out ballasts to change, and brighter, more constant lighting. Fluorescent bulbs for these old fixtures are getting harder to find and more expensive when

you do find them. This project is approximately \$3700.00. This includes 25 new lights and installation.

The next project in the Spring is putting leaf guard on the Link and Family Life Center gutters. This will stop leaf-clogged gutters and stop the ice dams that build up in the gutters during the winter. The gutters aren't draining completely because of the leaves. We will have 3 estimates soon.

The final project is the replacement of the Family Life Center chairs. The current chairs have been in constant use since 1996 and many of them are falling apart, stained, or just not in usable condition. The new chairs are approximately \$52.00 each and can come in vinyl or cloth seat covers. We hope to get individuals or families to sponsor the purchase of a chair(s). We would like to replace as many of the old chairs as we can; 200 will be the initial goal.
