## Letter from the Pastor

It's so good to be back in the swing of things at church with masks off and no distancing! For me, Vacation Bible School was particularly meaningful this year. The crowd of kids was smaller (as expected) and we kept the program shorter on purpose. But just seeing all the children together in one room singing, learning God's Word, having fun, and praising Jesus made me so grateful for simple gifts we often take for granted. The Holy Spirit will unfailingly bless us with joy and a sense of renewal whenever we come together in the name of Jesus.

Here are a few things that we can look forward to in August and September:

- We will return to Holy Communion with wafers and wine on the last weekend of July.
- We'll have a formal installation of our new Director of Music, Mark Meuser, at all the traditional services on the weekend of August 14-15. We are excited to have Mark join us. He will begin regular choir rehearsals the first Wednesday in September. All are welcome to join the choirs!
- Greeters, ushers, and communion assistants will be back in action for our worship services—volunteers are always welcome!
- Saturday, July 31st, will be “dumpster day” at church. Can you come and help? We were able to do a lot of painting and freshening up of our church building during the pandemic; now we need to sort out some clutter. Your help will be very much appreciated!
- We'll celebrate a full return to Sunday School for all ages on Rally Day, August 22nd.
- We'll hold our annual Outdoor Worship Service and Church Picnic on Sunday, August 29th along with our “Back to School Bash” for our young people.
- On Sunday, September 5th, we'll have a Ministry Fair in the Family Life Center. After a year and a half of curtailed activity, this will be a chance for everyone to review and celebrate all the different ways we can serve God here at St. John's, and also to re-commit ourselves to particular church ministries.
- Saturday, September 18th will be a particularly special day at church, as (in concert with Grove City's “Arts in the Alley” celebration) we enter a St. John's float in the parade, serve Coffee and Donuts for the public, and host several food trucks in our front parking lot. Come and join the fun on the 18th as we reach out to our community!
- September 25th will be RECOMMITMENT SUNDAY at St. John's. Pastor Patti and I will be emphasizing this event throughout the month of September.

As we move towards Recommitment Sunday at the end of September, we are going to reach out in a special way to all member households of St. John's. Please make a special effort to come to church on September 24th-25th. After such a challenging year, we need to make a concerted effort to reconnect with each other and recommit ourselves as a church family to worship, outreach, learning and service in Jesus' name. I'm looking forward to seeing you all in church!

**COLLIN BEAR**

**MEET COLLIN BEAR.** This well loved bear lives with the family of Jill and Tim Althoff. After their son, Collin, was stillborn, the grief was immeasurable. This bear was given to them during this time of pain and loss. Since then, Collin Bear has been a part of their family, helping to ease some of their pain and emptiness while giving the family a tender reminder of a son/brother who would now be ten and half years old.

At "Serving Like Jesus" last month, our youth unboxed and prepared 300 bears for CTA. CTA stands for Carrying Tender Angels\*. It's also the initials for Collin Timothy Althoff. The Althoffs started this ministry to help others who are also grieving the loss of a child. CTA partners with five local hospitals and provides 300 to 400 bears yearly to grieving families.

The Althoff family are devoted members of St. John's and a special part of our faith web. If you'd like to support their ministry, you can make a check out to "St. John's Lutheran" and drop it off in the church office. Please note in the memo that it's for "Carrying Tender Angels". Your donation will provide grieving parents with something tangible to carry in their arms, as they will forever carry their tender angels with them in their hearts.

*\*Carrying Tender Angels (CTA) is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. Our mission is to bring parents of a stillbirth or early infant loss comfort as they leave the hospital by presenting them with a beautiful teddy bear to carry in their arms home. CTA also provides bereaved families with resources and information to assist and support them during their healing process as well as promote community education and awareness surrounding infant and pregnancy loss.*
