Letter from the Associate Pastor

Dear Disciples of Jesus,

As you know, every year, the NALC gathers for a week of study, prayer, and celebration. Our theme this year was **God the Father Creates**. Our attention was drawn to the person of God, the Father. This was the focus of the theological conference portion of the convocation, and several speakers pointed to the nature and being of God, the Father, who is creator of heaven and earth.

If you remember your catechism, the first article of the Apostle's Creed states: *I believe in God the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth*. The Catechism then asks: *What does this mean?* This is the explanation:

I believe that God has made me and all that exists. He has given me and still preserves my body and soul with all their powers. He provides me with food and clothing, home and family, daily work, and all I need from day to day. God also protects me in time of danger and guards me from every evil. All this he does out of fatherly and divine goodness and mercy, though I do not deserve it. Therefore, I surely ought to thank and praise, serve and obey him. This is most certainly true.

Martin Luther was always careful to emphasize that all we have and are, indeed, our justification and eternal salvation are not because of our words or deeds, but solely the proper work of God, growing out of his heart and very being.

During the month of September, we will focus our worship and preaching on the understanding of God's giving and generosity, and how our lives mirror this same attitude. We will look at our Biblical beliefs and values that shape our understanding of our possessions, our money, our time and our giving of all of those. We will look at the difference between giving and generosity and how one necessarily shapes the other where our attitude is concerned. Each Sunday, we will focus on different aspects of this through the Old Testament, through the New Testament, and through our relationship with God and one another.

The last Sunday of September will be our opportunity to renew our commitments to serve God in his kingdom here on earth. We will complete commitment cards which we will have received on the first Sunday of September, and celebrate all that God has done for us, with us, and through us.

May this be a time of resetting our hearts and minds toward God's purpose for us, a time of being renewed in worship and this family of faith, and a time of recommitment to God and one another to be good stewards of all that we have received through his grace and favor.

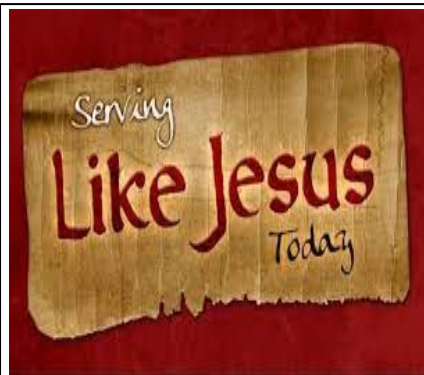

As the new choir director, I look forward to meeting everyone and to continue St. John's strong tradition of praising God through music.

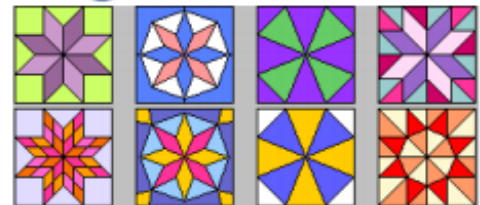

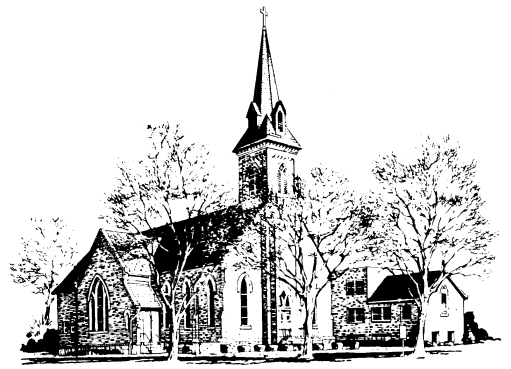
