ANNOUNCEMENT CONCERNING FACE COVERINGS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING AT ST.

<u>JOHN'S</u>: The St. John's Council met Monday, August 16th, and agreed on a stance regarding masks in response to the increase of COVID cases in Grove City, Franklin County, and Ohio. We recommend all individuals to wear masks and socially distance, regardless of vaccination status. It is recommended all congregation members and visitors wear masks in all indoor group settings, such as meetings, classes, and worship services, though it is not presently a requirement.
