Both the main doors facing Columbus Street and side entrance door with handicapped ramp get the worst of the winter weather.

During the week additional snow clearing of the entrances for staff and daily events would be a great help. If you can commit to one day a week, it would mean the world of difference, and will make our paths much safer.
