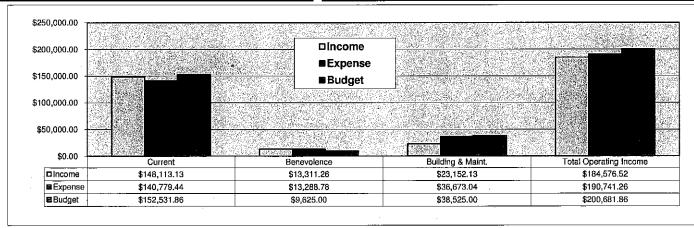

- I am deeply thankful for the members of the Accessibility Funding Team— Dan Yeater, Pastor Don Allman, Mistie Clark, Steve Johnston, Ike Stage, and Dan Czaplicki—for the prayer, thought, and time they've put into the proposed strategy to fund the envisioned addition to our church building. May God bless us with wisdom, generosity and determination as we move forward with this important project!
- Currently our regular 9:30 a.m. Sunday school class (between services) is studying the book of 1 Thessalonians.
- The Sunday evening Bible Study on Daniel was well attended and we had excellent discussion each week. Another evening Bible study will be announced soon.
- Our youth education programs (Sunday school, confirmation, Connect, high school) continue in full gear.
- A tech team has identified several audio-visual needs and possibilities for St. John's. Our first (and most costly) priority is to create a better electronic infrastructure to provide reliable and fast internet service and wireless connectivity throughout the church campus. Soon after installing the new infrastructure, we will begin purchasing and installing audio/visual equipment that will make it easier for volunteers and staff to record our worship services and educational events. We have already made improvements to our audio system in the main sanctuary. If you would like to contribute towards these important improvements, please let me know!
- Promise Keepers, our men's Bible discussion group, is meeting every Thursday at 8:00 a.m. in 103-4. Currently we're working through 1-2 Samuel and 1-2 Kings.
- Pastor Patti and I appreciate being notified when church members have been hospitalized or are dealing with health issues.
- My quest to visit all the member households of St. John's has now resumed as a greater number of people are feeling less tentative about having visitors in their homes.
- Staff and administrative duties are proceeding well.
