- Coordinate all matters related to our physical spaces with Jason Bosse, our Facilities and Grounds Manager.
- Notify a member of the Property Team with any questions, concerns, or proposed projects.
- Leave every area cleaner and more organized than you found it. This simple habit helps us keep our facilities welcoming to all.
- Keep all items at least 24 inches from the ceiling in rooms and closets to ensure compliance with fire codes.
- Use the provided sign holders and bulletin boards when promoting events. Please avoid taping signs to doors, windows, or walls tape damages surfaces we've worked hard to maintain.
- Donate thoughtfully. Items should be placed only in the collection area designated for that ministry. If you have items you think the church might need, check with the relevant ministry leader or leave a message with the church secretary. Someone will follow up to determine whether the items are suitable. Unsolicited donations can create clutter and extra work for others.
- Volunteer to help care for our outdoor spaces. Please indicate your availability on the salmon sheet.

**RENOVATION PROJECT UPDATE** – Work is expected to begin July 21 on the renovation projects that were approved at the special congregational meeting. The plan is to install the new HVAC units July 21 thru August 25. New lighting controls are scheduled for the week of July 21. Scaffolding for the bell tower work is currently scheduled to begin the week of August 4, with completion of repairs by October 6. Stained glass work is planned to begin at the beginning of September. Updates will be provided as the project progresses.
