"I said many times, adamantly, that we were not giving up. That as long as we had a road to recovery, we would stay on it. The path was paved by the doctors and surgeons whom continued to tell us "Phil has a chance". All we needed was to hear those words. Words that Phil, Kristen, Kelly, Joe and I were told.

"Words that we lived by every day of this constant fight to win, to overcome a failing body, to awake with a renewed glimmer of hope from the day before. Day after day of battling and pushing to heal lungs that were so fragile from four trips to the operating room and pneumonia that continued to creep back. We prayed. We cried. We asked God for healing. We asked for strength, and then mercy. Our pastors visited and prayed. The pastor and congregation from the church Phil's grandfather started prayed relentlessly, "In Phil's words".

"We stayed together in the Critical Care Unit this last time for 55 days as a family, never leaving. This was our new home. We continued on the road, the path, the fight. After waiting and watching and praying, we found the path to a new journey, to a forever home without the pain and suffering of a body that could no longer battle. We gathered around as family, naming each child and grandchild, so our presence was felt and known. With the prayers of our pastor from St. John's and the pastor from Apostolic Gospel Church, we held him in our arms and watched him go on his last journey home. Praise God from whom all blessings flow!

"Along with my children, I wish to thank St. John's for the many cards, food, love, and overwhelming support all the weeks while my husband was in the hospital. We are very thankful for the many visits from Pastor Seth and Pastor Cox with our grateful appreciation of Pastor Patti staying with Phil. We are without words for the outpouring of love at the visitation and service along with the meal. Many thanks to the Bereavement Team and all whom made their presence to remember Phil. We are forever grateful,"






