URGENT NEWS REGARDING ST. JOHN'S EMAIL: Recently, the primary email account of St. John's, secretary@stjohnsgc.org, was compromised, resulting in emails being sent containing links to open which will result in attempts to steal other email accounts. This is different from other scam emails we have seen in the past in that the valid church email account had been used. The scammers were able to corrupt the email account and up secondary authentication steps to take control in order to send messages to the contacts within. If you received one of these unsolicited emails, and clicked a link or opened an attachment, please contact your email admin, if possible, and make attempts to secure your inbox by changing your account login credentials. attempt to resolve this issue, please send church communications secretary this address. to the via email kmullins@stjohnsgc.org.
